



Welcome to the 2019 Summer Reading Program at the Oxford Public Library! The following are a few rules to help answer any questions you may have concerning the program. If you have any questions, please ask any of our staff. We will all be happy to assist you in any way we can.

- The program is open to everyone and anyone!
- SRP registration begins online on **Wednesday, May 1st**. Books checked out from **May 28th** onward are eligible for the program. The last day to sign up for the program is **Monday, July 22nd**. The last day to turn in Bingo/Gameboard pages will be **Thursday, July 25th**. The SRP ending party will be **Friday, July 26th**. This is when prizes will be announced.
 - Participants may register online or in the library. The online registration and other SRP information will be on OPL's website, www.oxfordpl.org/srp.
 - Any material checked out before **Monday, May 27th** is ineligible for the program. Only materials that have been checked out (in the library or online via Camellianet, Capstone, Big Timber Media, or ABDO) may be used. Ebooks are easily accessed from OPL's website, www.oxfordpl.org/ebooks.
 - One Bingo/Gameboard page may be presented per day.
- A parent may present Gameboard pages for a child if necessary.
- Books must be appropriate for the child's reading level.
- Every patron that signs up for the program will need a library card. A parent will need to sign with his child, accepting responsibility, for the child to receive card of his own. Please bring your driver license and a piece of recently postmarked mail as proof of residency.



- Items cannot be checked out and presented on the same day.
- “How to” books, cookbooks, magazines, and “share books” do not count as part of the Summer Reading Program. Audio Books and e-books are welcome.
- All activities are free of charge. Patrons may attend as many of the activities as they choose. Please see the calendar for activities.
- We are excited to have each of our patrons and families join us this summer for our Summer Reading Program. Our hope is to make the reading program a fun time for everyone. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask one of our staff.
- Students who want to turn in their reading history to teachers who offer bonus points may have their histories printed out. Talk to a staff person for help with this. Books for the program may be shared with family members for the Bingo/Gameboard pages; printouts will only show individual card circulations.



PRIZES

Easy/Juvenile: Participants will receive a Galaxy Gameboard to log reading progress. Color a star in your path for each book (or 100 pages) you read. Each time you land on a planet in your galactic journey, a prize will be awarded. Turn in the complete Gameboard to register for the grand prize. After the Gameboard is complete, a log will be issued for further logging. For every five books logged, your name will be entered into the grand prize drawing.

Adult/Youth: Participants will receive a Bingo page with reading suggestions in the spaces. A Bingo on the card earns a prize. Turn the complete card in to register for the grand prize. After the page is complete, a log will be issued for further reading. For every five books logged, your name will be entered into the grand prize drawing.

Note: An older child or adult that reads five books to a younger child may count one book on his log.

GRAND PRIZES

When the Gameboard or Bingo page is completed, your name will be put into a drawing for a grand prize! After that, a log will be issued. For every five books logged, your name will be entered into the grand prize drawing!

Names will be drawn at the end of the SRP Ending Event on **July 26th**. You do not have to be present to win the grand prize. There will be other prizes awarded, however; you must be present to win one of those. Once your name is drawn, you have five business days to claim your prize. (If you are not present, you will be notified immediately after the program via whatever method you specified at registration.) If an age group’s grand prize is not claimed, OPL will redraw.
