



Welcome to the 2020 Summer Reading Program at the Oxford Public Library! The following are a few rules to help answer any questions you may have concerning the program. If you have any questions, please ask any of our staff. We will all be happy to assist you in any way we can.

- The program is open to everyone and anyone!
- SRP registration begins online on **Monday, June 1st**. Books checked out from **May 26th** onward are eligible for the program. The last day to sign up for the program is **Monday, July 20th**. The last day to log will be **Thursday, July 23rd**. The SRP ending party will be **Friday, July 24th**. This is when prizes will be announced.



- Participants may register online or in the library. The online registration and other SRP information will be on OPL's website, www.oxfordpl.org/srp.
- Any material checked out before **Monday, May 26th** is ineligible for the program. Only materials that have been checked out (in the library or online via Camellianet, Capstone, Big Timber Media, or ABDO) may be used. Ebooks are easily accessed from OPL's website, www.oxfordpl.org/ebooks.
- Books must be appropriate for the child's reading level.

- Every patron that signs up for the program will need a library card. A parent will need to sign with his child, accepting responsibility, for the child to receive card of his own. Please bring your driver license and a piece of recently postmarked mail as proof of residency.
- Items cannot be checked out and logged on the same day.
- "How to" books, cookbooks, magazines, and "share books" do not count as part of the Summer Reading Program. Audio Books and e-books are welcome.
- All activities are free of charge. Patrons may attend as many of the activities as they choose. Please see the calendar for activities.
- Registration is required for many activities to allow OPL staff to accommodate for safe social distancing and prepare for the activity.



- We are excited to have each of our patrons and families join us this summer for our Summer Reading Program. Our hope is to make the reading program a fun time for everyone. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask one of our staff.
- Students who want to turn in their reading history to teachers who offer bonus points may have their histories printed out. Talk to a staff person for help with this. Books for the program may be shared with family members for the logging; printouts will only show individual card circulations.

PRIZES

Participants will log reading progress online using the Beanstack app or website; see information and link at www.oxfordpl.org/srp. Badges for reading and participation in SRP activities may be earned throughout the program, using the Beanstack app or website. The badges will indicate when a prize has been earned.

Note: An older child that reads five books to a younger child may count those minutes on his log. An adult that reads five books to a younger child may count those books as one book on his log.

GRAND PRIZES

Each badge earned will unlock tickets. Each ticket earned may be assigned to the grand prize of the participant's choice. Drawing will be made from the ticket pools.

Names will be drawn at the end of the SRP Ending Event on **July 24th**. You do not have to be present to win the grand prize. There will be other prizes awarded, however; you must be present to win one of those. Once your name is drawn, you have five business days to claim your prize. (If you are not present, you will be notified immediately after the program via whatever method you specified at registration.) If an age group's grand prize is not claimed, OPL will redraw.

NOTE: If social distancing guidelines do not allow OPL to have an in-house event, drawings will take place via live event on social media.
