

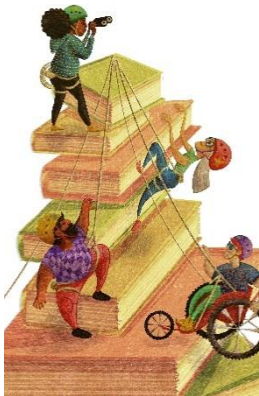

Welcome to the 2024 Summer Reading Program at the Oxford Public Library! The following are a few rules to help answer any questions you may have concerning the program.

If you have any questions, please ask any of our staff. We will all be happy to assist you in any way we can. Please visit www.oxfordpl.org/srp for more information.

- The program is open to everyone and anyone with an Oxford Public Library card.
- SRP registration begins online on **Wednesday, May 1**.
- Books checked out from **Tuesday, May 28-Wednesday, July 10** are eligible for the program. The last day to sign up for the program is **Monday, July 8**. The last day to log will be **Thursday, July 11**. The SRP ending party will be **Friday, July 12**.



- Participants may register online or in the library. The online registration and other SRP information will be on OPL's website, www.oxfordpl.org/srp. Participants will log reading progress using log sheets provided at the Summer Reading Table (located to the right of the elevator on the bottom floor).

- **Any material checked out before Tuesday, May 28 is ineligible for the program.** Only materials that have been checked out (in the library or online via Camellianet, Capstone, Big Timber Media, or ABDO) may be used. Ebooks are easily accessed from OPL's website, www.oxfordpl.org/ebooks.

- Books must be appropriate for the child's reading level.
- Every patron that signs up for the program will need a library card. A parent

will need to sign with his child, accepting responsibility, for the child to receive a card of his own. Please bring your driver license and a piece of recently postmarked mail as proof of residency.

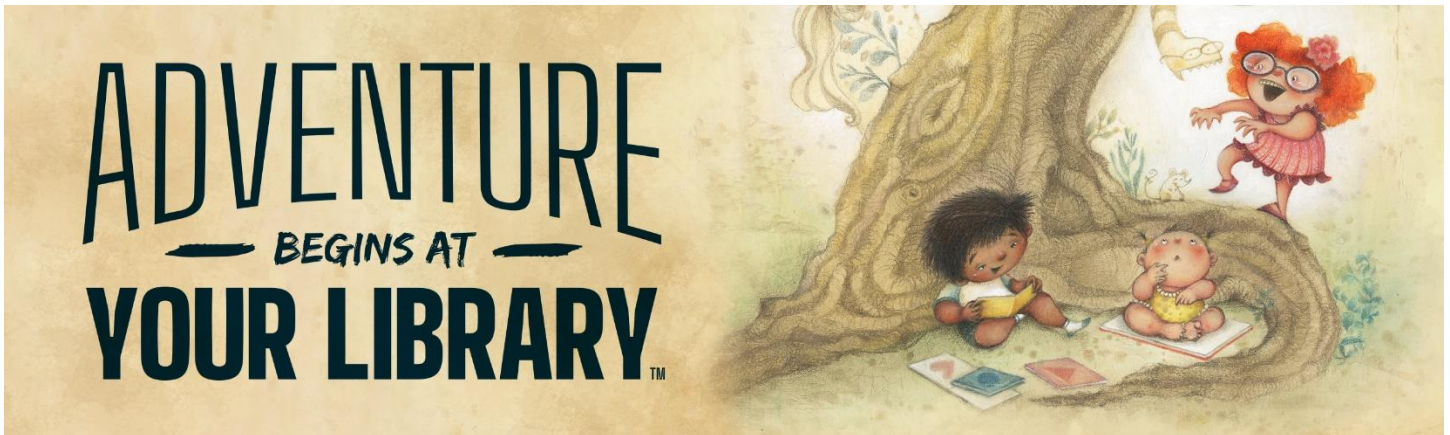
- Items cannot be checked out and logged on the same day.
- "How to" books, cookbooks, and magazines do not count as part of the Summer Reading Program. Audio Books and e-books are welcome!
- All activities are free of charge. Please see the calendar at www.oxfordpl.org/srp for information about planned activities.
- We are excited to have each of our patrons and families join us this summer for our Summer Reading Program. Our hope is to make the reading program a fun time for everyone. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask one of our staff.
- Students who want to turn in their reading history to teachers who offer bonus points may have their histories printed out. Talk to a staff person for help with this. Books for the program may be shared with family members for logging; printouts will only show individual card circulations.



PRIZES

Participants will earn prizes by turning in reading logs. Multiple reading logs throughout the summer may be turned in with prize redemption each time, however, no more than three logs may be turned in on the same day. Completed logs will be entered into a drawing for grand prizes on July 12.

Note: An older child that reads five books to a younger child may count those minutes on his log.



Adults

Adults are welcome to join the program, as well! Adults will log their books using a bookmark. Complete the bookmark to earn a prize. Multiple bookmarks can be submitted.
